FROM FATHER HAYES



Greetings in Christ Jesus! It still surprises me that it has been a whole year since my time as a teaching parish seminarian at St. Patrick's and St. Catherine's ended. Fr. Miller asked me to write a bit on what my first year as a priest has been like.

Well, I will always remember this past year. Of course, the central grace was the ordination. I know that many of you had wanted to come and were not able. Despite the small numbers, it was a beautiful Mass. When I prostrated in front of the Altar, it really struck me that the Lord was calling me to give everything over to Him, all the joys and sufferings, all my talents and inabilities, and all my love to Him and His Church.

It has been a joy to live that out in my current assignment. I am the parochial vicar of the St. John Paul II Area Faith Community, consisting of three parishes: Holy Trinity in Winsted, Holy Family in Silver Lake, and St. Pius X in Glencoe. In addition to this assignment, I am the main Hispanic minister of the Spanish-speaking community in the area. I celebrate a Spanish Mass every Sunday in Glencoe.

The pandemic added a little twist to things. It was difficult to get to know the parishioners at first. Mass attendance was restricted, and the masks made it a little difficult to recognize people. A small thing that I noticed was that I missed being able to shake someone's hand when I met them and when I greeted them after Mass. It was a little slow to get to know the "personality" of the parish. In all of this, however, the Lord has blessed my priesthood with many meaningful encounters with parishioners and sharing the Gospel with them.

Some of my favorite memories have been giving the anointing of the sick. God has amazed me numerous times how He guided numerous situations so that I could anoint a dying parishioner, even with all the Covid restrictions. It is a privileged place to see God's grace working in the soul of a dying person as well as His grace working in the family members.

I remember my time at St. Patrick's and St. Catherine's with great gratitude. I am especially grateful for all the support and prayers you gave me

and still do. I hope to stop in and visit soon. Please know of my prayers for you. Please continue to pray for me.
