

PARISH NURSE PROGRAM:

Age spots are considered harmless. They usually appear on hands, feet, back, and face. In general, they have "rounded edges", while **cancerous spots** usually have "**ragged**, **irregular edges and color.**" If these are noted, seek medical attention. To avoid age spots, minimize sun exposure and use a sunscreen with sun protection **SPF 15** cover with **protective clothing.** Let's enjoy a healthy Minnesota summer.
